Directions to All SCHPA Locations

Clover

- From downtown Clover: Take Hwy 55 east approximately 1 mile turn right on Quinn road across from the shopping center. Clover recreation complex entrance is located 3 blocks on right.

Florence

- Approaching Florence on eastbound I20 take I95 south exit onto Hwy 76 east; keep going till you see a mini maxi warehouse sign and check cashing business on the right; turn right on Santiago drive. McCleod Park is located on the left; the courts are visible from the road.

Hartsville

- From Hwy 151 by-pass, look for Pam's Restaurant and the Action Ford dealer, turn north onto Fourteenth St. towards Hartsville. Byerly Park is located at the corner of Fourteenth St. and Russell Rd.

Honea Path

- The facility is located behind the Honea Path Fire Department. Parking is available in the municipal parking lot behind the Main Street shops.

Lockhart

- From York, go south on Hwy 49 for about 20 miles to Lockhart; bear right at intersection at top of hill onto Hwy 9. Proceed approximately 1 1/2 miles; the entrance to the park is on the right.
- From Spartanburg, take Hwy 9 and go toward Lockhart. The entrance to the park is on the left, just before you get into town.
- From Union, proceed toward Lockhart on Hwy 49; turn left at intersection onto Hwy 9. Continue approximately 1 mile; the entrance to the park is on the right.

Newberry

- Located off I26, from interstate take Hwy 121 at exit #72, from either direction and go toward Newberry. Follow Hwy 121 for approximately 2 1/2 miles. Stay on Hwy 121 when it turns right at the traffic signal; proceed 1/2 mile and Marion Davis Park is on left.
- From Union take Hwy 176 to Whitmire, then Hwy 121 to Newberry. When Hwy 176 crosses I26 follow above directions.

York

- From I-85, go south on Hwy 321 about 18 miles, turn left onto Hwy 5 by-pass. Go approximately 3 miles, turn right at traffic signal (Hwy 49). Continue 3/4 mile and turn left onto Ross-Cannon St., after approximately 1 mile and you will see the light poles of the York Recreational Complex, on the left.
- From Columbia, travel north on Hwy 321, at the edge of town, turn onto Hwy 49 and go all the way through town. as you leave town on 49, turn right onto Ross-Cannon St.; after approximately 1 mile and you will see the light poles of the York Recreational Complex, at park on the left.
